



2021-2022 Out-of-Area Admission Application Request

Out-of-Area means that a student's residence of record is outside of the catchment area of the school to which they are applying.

There is no guarantee of admission when applying to an "Out-of-Area" school. Admission is based on available space at the school. Consideration will be given to "Out-of-Area" students **after** all in-area applications have been accommodated.

While schools may not be able to accept all Out-of-Area students, we have confidence in the excellent programming available in all TVDSB schools. Where capacity issues warrant, a process will be used to provide a limited number of spaces to "Out-of-Area" students.

Transportation is not provided for students who chose to attend an "Out-of-Area" school. Families may submit a Choice of School Transportation Application to access transportation but space on buses may not be available. Families need to plan to make their own transportation arrangements as it is the responsibility of families to transport their children to and from school, if they chose to attend an "Out-of-Area" school.

Notification of decisions will be provided by February 11, 2021.**
